

## **Reopening Our Church For Sunday Worship Service**

1. There will be only one worship service (10:00 a.m.) for the foreseeable future. Other church activities will not resume until further notice.
2. We encourage anyone with certain underlying medical conditions to remain at home for the time being. Please consider your own vulnerability and the vulnerabilities others may have in deciding whether to attend worship services.
3. All hymnals, Bibles, offering envelopes and pencils in the pew racks will be removed.
4. Entry into the church will be through the front doors only. The rear doors will remain locked.
5. Observe the 6-foot social distancing recommendation as much as possible.
6. The names of everyone attending worship will be recorded upon entry in case there needs to be any contact tracing. According to the Richland County Health Department a contact is being within 6 feet of an infected person for more than 15 minutes.
7. If you have had a fever within the previous 72-hours please do not attend the worship service. If you are unsure, your temperature can be taken with an infrared thermometer upon entry.
8. Greeters will remind everyone upon entering the building to sanitize their hands. Hand sanitizers will be placed in multiple locations throughout the building.
9. There should be no handshaking among congregants.
10. Everyone is expected to wear masks per guidance from the Richland County Health Department. Disposable masks will be provided for those who do not have them.
11. Wearing gloves is optional. Gloves should be worn by those handling items that could be touched by someone else.
12. Ushers will wear masks and gloves.
13. Ushers will distribute bulletins and escort congregants to the pews.
14. Individual and families will be seated at the ends of the pews. Every other pew will be empty.
